5. Art should be done on an 11 x 17 piece of paper or poster board. (Horizontal format ONLY.)
6. Digital/computer aided art is acceptable.
7. No photography. No glitter.
8. Artwork must be original and not violate U.S. copyright or trademark law.
9. The winning artwork will be displayed at the City's skate parks, as well as on the website **TakeBackTheWall.com**.

**Submitting entries:**
